

MGA 2010 Tournament Schedule

January 16, 2010 – Two Man Combo

Two-man teams, pick your own partner. Flighted based on team handicap. You may play with anyone, but maximum six stroke difference allowed between indexes for flighting purposes. Holes #1-#6 best ball, holes #7-#12 scramble, holes #13-#18 alternate shot. All scoring will be based on gross scores, except the last flight will be net of the average of the two players' handicaps.

February 20, 2010 – Red Ball

Four man teams (A, B, C, D players) determined by pro shop. Scoring will be based on gross scores, with two separate competitions – red ball and scramble. Prize money will be split 60% to red ball and 40% to scramble. Teams may not finish in the money in both formats. Each player will play red ball on designated holes while the other three players play a scramble - both gross scores should be recorded separately on the scorecard. **The player playing the red ball does not participate in the scramble portion of the tournament.** If the red ball is lost, the team is eliminated from the red ball portion of the tournament, but will continue to compete in the scramble portion of the tournament. **From the point that the red ball is lost, the four players will play an elimination (Pinehurst) scramble.** This means that the player that hit the last shot cannot hit the next shot. For example, if the "A" player's tee ball is used, he cannot hit second shot, or if the "D" player makes the putt, he cannot hit the tee ball on next hole. The elimination format applies only after the red ball is lost. This is to ensure that only four players are playing in the scramble at all times

March 20, 2010 – 2 Man Low and Total .

Each player plays his own ball until completing the hole, then the lower of the two net scores is recorded as the "Low" score for that hole and the combined net scores are recorded as the "Total" for that hole. All scoring will be based on Net scores, (six shot rule applies). We will also pay one individual in tournament or all ties with lowest gross score and one individual and all ties with lowest net score.

Team Handicap will be total of 50% of lowest players handicap plus 25% of highest players handicap.

April 17, 2010 – 4 Man 2 Best Ball

Four man teams (A, B, C, D players) determined by pro shop. Team will record two low net scores per hole. Pays team winner of front nine, back nine and overall 18 holes. We will also pay one individual in tournament or all ties with lowest gross score and one individual and all ties with lowest net score.

May 15, 2010 – Blind 3

Individual stroke play tournament. For tee times, Pro Shop will randomly assign tee positions. After all play finished, there will be a drawing by scoreboard, to determine three man teams. Winners will be based on total net of all 3 players.

June 11,12 2010 – Member/Guest.

July 10, 2010 – 1 Man Red, White and Blue Tournament

Each player plays his own ball until completing the hole. All scoring will be based on gross scores, except the last flight will be net. The first six holes, the players will tee off from the red tees. The second six holes the players will tee off from the white tees and the last six holes the players will tee off from the blue tees. Tournament will be flighted based on handicaps.

August 21, 2010 – 2 Man Best Ball/Worst Ball

Shamble format-both players tee off. Select the best drive of the two and play your own ball until you hole out. *On all par threes you must play your own ball the entire hole.* On even holes record the best ball of the team. On odd holes record the worst ball (ex.-Hole 5-you make 3 your partner makes 5 record the 5 as your score). Maximum score on any hole is double par. All scoring will be based on gross scores, except the last flight will be net of the average of the two players' handicaps (six shot rule applies). Team Handicap will be total of 50% of lowest players handicap plus 25% of highest players handicap.

September 11,12 2010 – MGA Championships

Each player plays his own ball until completing the hole. All scoring will be based on gross scores, except the last flight will be net. Tournament will be flighted based on handicaps.

October 9 2010 – Two Man Alternate shot. Both players tee off on first hole they start on. Select the best tee shot. From that point until finish all 18 holes, you alternate shot. Person who putts out does not tee off on next hole. Only on first shot of tournament should there ever be two people hitting. Team handicap is 50% of each player's course handicap.

November 13, 2010 – Two Man Scramble – Flighted based on Handicap. Team Handicap will be total of 50% of lowest players handicap plus 25% of highest players handicap.
