2019 USGA Major Rule Change of the Week...

<u>Major Rule Change</u> - No penalty for Moving a Ball on the Putting Green

<u>Rule 13.1d</u> - No Penalty for accidentally moving your ball or ball-marker on the putting green.

USGA "Reasons for Change"

- The shape, slope and condition of many putting greens today increases the chances that a ball at rest on the putting green might move, and it can be difficult to determine if the player or natural causes moved the ball.
- Most "Ball Move" situations occur on the putting green and involve minimal movement.
- When a ball moves while a player is doing nothing more than taking normal actions to prepare for a stroke, it can seem unfair for the player to be penalized.
