2019 USGA Major Rule Change of the Week...

<u>Major Rule Change</u> - Substitution of a ball always allowed when taking relief.

<u>Rule 14.3</u> - Under rule 14.3, when taking relief, the player will always be allowed the choice to substitute a ball or to use the original ball, including...

USGA "Reasons for Change"

- The requirement to use the original ball in some relief situations but not others is confusing, hard to remember and leads to unnecessary penalties. Taking a consistent approach that always allows a player taking relief the choice to substitute a ball or use the original ball is much simpler.
- There is no need for a different procedure based on whether the player is taking relief with or without penalty.
