2019 USGA Major Rule Change of the Week...

<u>Major Rule Change</u> - Time for search before a ball is lost

Rule 18.2 - Under rule 18.2, the time for a ball search (before the ball becomes lost) will be REDUCED from 5 minutes to 3 minutes.

USGA "Reasons for Change"

- Limiting the search period to 3 minutes is more consistent with the underlying principle that golf is to be played in a prompt and continuous way, without long pauses in play.
- In most cases, if the ball is going to be found, it will be found in the first 3 minutes. Although this change may increase lost balls, on average the overall impact should speed up play.
