2019 USGA Major Rule Change of the Week...

Major Rule Change - Unplayable ball in bunker

<u>Under Rule 19.36</u>, The player will have an extra option allowing relief outside the bunker using the <u>back on the line</u> procedure, but for a total of two penalty strokes.

USGA "Reasons for Change"

It is not uncommon for a player to need to take unplayable ball relief in a bunker, such as when the ball is very close to the bunker wall or lip.

Playing from a bunker can be very difficult for some players, especially when the bunker has a steep wall.

- This can present particular problem in stroke play because a player must finish the hole an so cannot simply pick up and move to the next hole after multiple tries to play the ball from the bunker.
- Giving those players an option to take relief outside the bunker will allow them to keep playing rather than be disqualified.
