## 2019 USGA Major Rule Change of the Week...

Major Rule Change - Use of damaged clubs during round

## Under Rule 4.1

- A Player will be allowed to keep using and/or to repair any club damaged during the round, no matter what the damage and even if the player damaged it in anger.
- A player will not be allowed to replace a damaged club, except when it is damaged during the round by and outside influence or natural forces or by someone other than the player or his or her caddie.

## USGA "Reasons for Change"

This rule change will greatly simplify the complex rules on damaged clubs.

Allowing a player to keep using or to repair any damaged club, regardless of the nature or cause of the damage, will benefit players In several ways.

The potential downside from a player's perspective is outweighed by the ability to use or repair any damaged club, as well as by the significant simplification that results. Click here to read the explanation of Rule 4.1
